The largest of the three **Talking First Aid Kits** has a set of nine convenient talking care packs organized by type of injury or emergency (Breathing/CPR; Bleeding; Shock; Head & Spine; Bone; Burns; Bites & Stings; and Basic). This particular kit sells for \$145.96. Each talking care pack includes accessories to assist in the treatment of the injury, as well as printed instructions complete with audio guidance to talk you through the steps necessary to handle the situation. With the squeeze of a button, a calm, clear voice provides you with the proper first aid step to manage the injury.

removable tip for both summer and winter traction. The handle has a flashlight. The telescopic shaft provides different height adjustments and can break down into two 22" pieces for travel and easy storage. Checklist For Preventing Falls At Home

Every year, thousands of older adults fall and hurt themselves. Falls are one of the main causes of injury and disability in people age 65 and older. Those who fall once are 2 to 3 times more likely to fall again. Falls are often caused by hazards that are easy to overlook. However, these hazards can also be easy to fix.

- ▶ Move furniture so that your path through a room is clear.
- ▶ Remove throw rugs on floors or use double-sided tape or a nonslip backing so the rug won't slip.
- ▶ Always keep objects off the floor. Pick up papers, books, shoes, or other things that are on the floor

The E-Z key turner is an enlarged key holder. There is probably no more difficult task than buttoning a button. This unique tool eliminates the stress and frustration by pulling the button or zipper into position. The pen and pencil cushions are designed in both shape and density to alleviate stress while providing a secure grip. The spoon and fork holders fit onto virtually any spoon and fork providing a secure grip. The lamp switch enlarger fits right over the existing switch to provide an easy, grasp.
