This enables people of all ages, incomes, and disabilities to connect with any ADRC partner organization and access a wide array of LTSS options in the community. The Orange County ADRC is led by a core partnership between the Orange County Office on Aging and Dayle McIntosh Center, and includes a wide array of extended partner organizations.
